We are waiting for the believers, we are waiting for the ahli Jannat to come.' Because the Jannat, without the inhabitants of the Jannat, it is not a real Paradise. What use is a palace if there is no king? What use is a kingdom if there is no king? But a king without a kingdom,

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he has the potential. The king without a kingdom, he is still a king. We are asking Allah to make us to be ready, insya'Allah, for that month.”

SHEYKH LOKMAN EFENDI HAZRETLERI

“The month of Ramazan is for us to look into our hearts and to clean. It is not just to stay away from food and the water. You tie a dog out there, Sheykh Efendi says, without food and water, you cannot say the dog is fasting. Fasting is more than that. Fasting is understanding what is the sickness that is inside and the sickness that is outside of you and to stay away from it. That time, you don’t have to read so many high level books. You know ‘what I’m watching, that is wrong. It’s going to bring a sickness.’ You are going to understand ‘I’m listening to this. This is no good.’ You are going to understand ‘I start

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talking, I start talking these things and it's making me to forget my fast, forget about Allah, putting darkness in my heart, no good. I stay away from it.'

You will understand by yourself. Your heart will start opening.

It is the month that we are entering, the Sultan of the months.

If the Sultan is coming, it's not the time for us to get ready.

When the Sultan is coming, every preparation should have been done.

The Sultan is coming already.

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If we know the Sultan is coming three months, six months, that is the time you start preparing. Eh, Muslims are very busy these days for everything else except for Allah. Everything else they say 'no, world will not wait, world will not understand, world has no mercy,' but when it comes to Allah, they are saying 'oh, Allah understands. Allah is merciful. We don't have to run for Allah, we must run for dunya, because dunya is not going to wait for us. In the month of Ramadan, pull back from dunya a little bit. Pull back from our ego a little bit. Start strong, may we end strong, insya'Allah. Find time to be quiet a little bit. Don't run around too much, don't do nonsense things too

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much, sit and be easy, make some zikr, make some extra Taffakur, don't be busy with the fitnah on the internet, twenty-four hours people are making fitnah. Interfering into things that you have no knowledge about, interfering into things that one day, if you don't stop, that fitnah is going to fall on top of you. Stay away from all of that, be busy doing other thing.

Alhamdulillah, our Sheykh is telling us, he is never telling us to be busy with the fitnah of the internet. So we stay away from it.

SHEYKH LOKMAN EFENDI HAZRETLERI

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THE FIRST NIGHT OF RAMADAN, BETWEEN MAGHREB AND ISHA:

- 2 Rakats Shukur Salah (Sala-tush-shukr) - In each Rakat: 1 Fatiha, 1 Kawthar, 1 Ikhlas. After the salah: 70 Istighfar, 70 Salat-i-Tunjina, then make dua.
- Salat-ut-Tasbih when the surah which is to be recite is- in each Rakat: 1 Fatiha, 3 Ayatu-l Kursi. (Can also be performed after the Isha)

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RECOMMENDED DUA FOR IFTAR DURING THE MONTH OF RAMADAN:

Since the Dua of a fasting person at iftar time will be more accepted, it is sunnah for one to make a Dua at that time.

Here we have compiled 6 recommended Dua that can be done before you break your fast:

1. As it is narrated from Ibnu Omar (Radiyallahu Anhumâ): “The Messenger of Allah (Sallellahu Aleyhi ve Sallem) said while breaking the fast:

ذَهَبَ الظَّمَأُ وَابْتَلَّتِ الْعُرُوقُ وَثَبَتَ الْأَجْرُ إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ

**Read As: Zehebe'z-zamau wabtelleti'-lurûku
wassebet'el Ajrü EnshaAllah**

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Translation:

The thirst is gone, the veins are wet, InshAllah the reward has been fixed.

(Ebû Dâvûd, es-Sünen, es-Siyâm:22, number:2357, p:343)

2. According to the narration from Mu'âz)
ibnu Zühre (Radiyallâhu Anh): "When the
Prophet (Sallallâhu Aleyhi ve Sallem) broke
his fast he used to say:

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صُئْتُ وَعَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْتُ.

Read As:

“Allahümme leke sumtü ve ala rizgika Aftartü”

Translation: 'O Allah, I fasted for You and broke my fast with Your sustenance.'"

(Ebû Dâvûd, es-Sünen, es-Siyâm:22, number:2358, p:343)

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3. According to the narration from Ibnu Abbas (Radiyahallahu Anh), the Prophet (PBUH) used to pray as follows at the time of iftar:

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صُومْنَا وَ عَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْنَا فَتَقَبَّلْ مِنَّا إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ.

Read As:

Allahümme leke sumna ve ala rizgika Aftarna fetegabbel minne inneke ente's semiul alîm.

Translation:

“Oh Allah! We fasted for you. We broke our fast with your sustenance. So accept it from us, for You are the only one who hears and knows fully.”

(ibnû's-Sünnî, 'Amelü'l-yevmi ve'l-leyle, number:479, 2/417; en-Nevevî, el-Ezkâr, number:547, 1/190)

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4. Yâ Azîm Iftar Dua:

In a hadith narrated by Enes (Radiyahallahu Anh), the Prophet (Sallallahu Alayhi wa Sallam) said: "If any Muslim fasts and says this prayer at the time of iftar, he will definitely be free from his sins, just like the day his mother gave birth to him.

Teach this Dua to your children, because this is a word that Allah Almighty and His Messenger love. With this, Allah Almighty puts the affairs of the worldly and the hereafter in order (of the person who make this Dua). :

يَا عَظِيمُ يَا عَظِيمُ! أَنْتَ إِلَهِي لَا إِلَهَ غَيْرُكَ، إِغْفِرْ لِي
الدَّنْبَ الْعَظِيمَ، فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الدَّنْبَ الْعَظِيمَ إِلَّا الْعَظِيمُ.

Read As:

Ya azimu Ya azim. Anta ilahi lâ ilahe Ğayruka,

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Aafirlizzenbel Azim, feinnehu la yaafiruzzenbel
Azime illelAzim.

Translation:

O Allah Almighty! My God is only You. There is
no God but You. Forgive me my great sins, surely
there is no one to forgive except You.'

5. The great companion Abdullah ibnu Amr
ibni'l-As (Radiyahallahu Anh) used to make the
following prayer while breaking the fast:

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ بِرَحْمَتِكَ الَّتِي وَسِعَتْ كُلَّ شَيْءٍ أَنْ تَغْفِرَ
لِي ذُنُوبِي.

Read As: "Allahümme 'inni ' As'Aluke
birahmatika'Allati wasiat külli shay'in tearali
zunûbi."

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Translation:

“O Allah, I pray that you will forgive my sins for me with your all-pervading mercy.”

All praise belongs to Allah Almighty, who owns (everything) and has power. All praise belongs to Allah Almighty, who resurrects the dead.'

Now, the fasting servant who has heard all this good news should use his fasting hours, especially the moments close to iftar, when his sins are not even written down, with dhikr and prayer.

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As a matter of fact, in a hadith narrated by Enes (Radiyahallahu Anh), the Prophet (peace be upon him) said: "Indeed, Allah Almighty and Celle said to the scribe angels: 'Do not write down a sin for my fasting servants after the afternoon prayer.' "reveals."

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**Salat-Ut-Tarawih:
After the Isha's Adhan, to be performed
in the following order:**

- The first sunnah of Isha: 4 Rakats
- Fard of 4 Rakats Isha
- Last sunnah of Isha: 2 Rakats
- 20 Rakats tarawih (salams every 4 rakats)
- 3 Rakats witr salah.

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Tarawih Prayer in the Osmanlı Dergâhı:

The muaazin recites a short Ramadan poem or Hymn, (In the first days it starts with “Marhaba Ya Shahr-i Ramadan” and in the last days of Ramadan it starts with “Elveda (Farewell) Ya Shahr-i Ramadan” and then the congregation recites Ikhlas-u Sharif 3 times and Salawat 1 time. Followed by the ummiyye (Allahumma salli âlâ sayyidina Muhammad'i-ninnebiyyi-l ummiyyi wa âlâ alihi wa sahbihi wa sallim.) and says 1 time Allâhumma salli âlâ sayyidina Muhammad. Continue in the same way after every fourth rakah. After completing 20 rakahs, the congregation recites salat-i ummiyye 3 times and then the muathin recites "Amanarrasulu", then 3 rakahs of witr prayer are performed and then the muathin continues as after every witr/sunnah prayer: Salawat, Ayatu-l Kursi and Tasbih.

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REWARDS OF THE 30 TARAWIH **SALAHS DAY BY DAY:**

According to the narrations of Abu Hurayra (r.a), our Prophet (SAW) said:

”Whoever performs tarawih salah believing in the virtue of Ramadan and expecting its reward from Allah, his past sins will be forgiven”

Hazrat Imam-i Ghazali said the following regarding the rewards of tarawih salah performed specifically for Ramadan: It was narrated by Hazrat Ali (ra):

1st night: All sins are forgiven

2nd night: His sins and those of his parents, if they are believers, will be forgiven

3rd night: Angels give good news and say: “O so-and-so person! Good news to you that Allah

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(Almighty) accepted your deed and got what you hoped for

4th night: Allah (Almighty) grants as much reward as having read the Torah, the Bible, the Psalms and the Quran

5th night: Allah (Almighty) grants rewards equal to those who pray in the Masjid Haram

6th night: Allah (Almighty) grants rewards equal to those who circumambulate Beyt-i Mamur

7th night: Allah (Almighty) grants the reward of fighting against Pharaoh and Haman alongside Moses (pbuh)

8th night: Allah (Almighty) grants rewards as if he was with the Prophet (pbuh) in the Battle of Badr

9th night: Allah (Almighty) gives the reward of worshiping with David (pbuh)

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10th night: Allah (Almighty) grants salvation in this world and the hereafter

11th night: The reward of accepted Umrah is granted

12th night: Sirat passes like lightning

13th night: He will be rewarded as if he had rebuilt Beytu-llah

14th night: Allah (Almighty) gives rewards as if he revived the Night of Kad'r until the morning

15th night: Allah (Almighty) accepts your need and . He bestows high degrees for you in the afterlife

16th night: When rising from his grave on the Day of Judgment, he will say "Lailahe illallah"

17th night: He sees his place in Heaven without leaving the world

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18th night: Reward is given like the reward given to shahiids and veterans

19th night: Allah (Almighty) will help you in this world and the hereafter

20th night: The person does not leave the world without seeing our Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) in his dream

21st night: All the angels on earth and in the sky pray for forgiveness for him. And Allah (Almighty) will not pass him away from this world to the afterlife unless He is pleased with that servant

22nd night: He will be rewarded as if he fed the orphans and widows of the Ummah of Muhammad (pbuh)

23rd night: He will be rewarded as if he freed the captives of the Ummah of Muhammad

24th night: He receives his acquittal from his right hand

25th night: The angel of death comes in the most beautiful form and gives him the good news of the blessings of heaven

26th night: By the command of Allah, angels protect the person from the evil of the devil

27th night: By the command of Allah, the gates of hell are closed

28th night: By the command of Allah, the gates of heaven are opened, and the person can enter from whichever gate he wishes

29th night: Prophet Ayyub A.S. patience reward is granted and all sins are forgiven.

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30th night: By the order of Allah, a caller calls out from under the Throne: "The servants who perform the tarawih salah at night are the servants who have been freed from hell. They are the ones who have been saved from the hell they feared and have hoped for and attained the Beauty of Allah." Allah (Almighty) says: (I swear on) My Glory and My Magnificence. I treated these servants of mine with amnesty for their rights. I have made the fire of hell forbidden to their bodies.

“ THE BEGINNING OF RAMADAN (THE FIRST TEN DAYS) IS MERCY,

THE MIDDLE IS FORGIVENESS (THE SECOND TEN DAYS)

AND THE END IS SALVATION FROM HELL FIRE (THE LAST TEN DAYS).”

This hadith shows that the companions of Badr had a special importance next to Allah and His Messenger (pbuh). It is recommended on the 17th night of Ramadan, to read the Blessed names of the Companions of Badr , it can be done after the Salat al Tarwih,

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The muezzin can recite the names, and the congregation should say "RadiAllhuan" after each name. It is also nice to recite Mevlid that night to commemorate the Companions of Badr.

You Will Be Tested

O Believers! This is Ramadan. This is a time for us to wake up. It is a time for us to understand what that enemy is and to fight those enemies inside. It is time for us to wake up and begin to fight that real *Jihad*, that *Jihad al-Akbar*, the *jihad* against to our nafs. Understand the stakes of this fight. If we lose, then we are counted as those who have made a hidden *shirk* and are slaves to our ego.

As our Sheykh, Sahib el-Sayf Sheykh Abdul Kerim el-Kibrisi el-Rabbani (KS) is saying: “When you are fighting against the pleasure of your ego then you are reaching somewhere. Otherwise, you are worshiping your ego. You have two places you are worshiping now. When you are worshiping to two places, what are you

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doing? *Shirk*. So many Muslims today are making *Shirk*. Hidden *Shirk*. Holy Prophet (PBUH) is saying, “That will be a hidden *Shirk* when you are going to aim to worship Allah but you are going to do what your ego wants. So then you are worshipping your ego.”

Our Grandsheykh is saying, “When you are worshipping to two gods, kill one of them. Destroy one of them and turn yourself to one.” Our egos are declaring themselves lords next to Allah (SWT). No other creatures that Allah (SWT) has created has ever declared itself to be an *ilah*, to be a Lord, except for that creature that Allah (SWT) has created, that He has put inside of us. To be in *ghaflat* and slip into obedience of the ego, it is in reality to serve and worship a pretender that is declaring lordship next to Allah (SWT).

As our Grandsheykh, Sheykh Mevlana Muhammad Nazim Adil el-Hakkani (KS) is saying:

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Every Prophet brought methods from Allah Almighty, for training our ego so that we can say, "O my Lord, I surrender to You." But your ego says to Allah, "No, I will not surrender." When Allah asked our ego, "Who are you?", the ego answered, "I am myself, and You are Yourself."

"You are You, and I am myself." So Allah Almighty ordered for the ego to be put into fire for one thousand years. He then took the ego out and asked it the same question.

The ego replied, "You are You and I am me." So he was ordered to be put into the cold part of hell for one thousand years, after which he was asked, "Who are you?" And the ego answered in the same way as before. Then it was ordered to be put into the valley of hunger for one thousand years, after a few days he was called again and asked again this same question,

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and this time it replied, “You are my Lord, and I am your servant.” The ego always saying, “I have Lordship.”

Lordship is only for Allah. The seal of prophet Muhammad PBUH brought the order from Allah for fasting. When it comes to hunger the ego comes down, and says, “No longer am I claiming to be Lord in front of You. I am your weak servant, and you are my Lord.” The one who can’t control himself, is terrible and dangerous. Fasting gives you the capability to put control on your ego, so that it listens to you. You may say, “do” and it does, or say, “Stop,” and it stops. Therefore, from the beginning up to the end, fasting is the main pillar of servanthood. Without it, no one can reach to be a real servant, because the ego is always winning otherwise. It takes a ride on your back and says, “Follow me.”

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O Believers! We are in the days and nights of Ramazan, when Allah (SWT) has given us the gift of fasting which weakens our ego. We now have the chance to take our ego back into our hands and to ride our egos, instead of letting it ride us. But who is going to teach you how to ride your ego? This is not a skill that you can get from books, from the internet, or from our imagination. When you go to a horse that is wild and unbroken, you cannot just sit on it and try to ride it. It will throw you off and break your neck.

Now you need to go to a master who is going to show you how to train it. When you are in the war, you need to be under the command of a general who is going to tell you where to go and what to do and when to do.

When you are in this greatest war, the *Jihad al-Akbar* against to your ego, you must have a guide. Our guide is the Holy Prophet (PBUH) and he has left that guidance and he has left that

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secret to the *Sahabi e-Kiram* to continue, who then passed it to the *Tabi'in*, who then passed it to the *Tabi'i Tabi'in* until the last day. This is *ahle Sunnah wal Jamaah*. This is the way of the people who follow the tradition of the Prophet. Never the *Sahabi e-Kiram* saying, 'I go directly to Allah.' Never the *Tabi'in* saying, 'I go directly to the Prophet.' Never the *Tabi'i Tabi'in* they say, 'I go directly to our Lord.' They all say, 'we took this knowledge from them, who took it from them, who took it from the Prophet, who took it from Allah.'

Our Sheykh is saying: Don't say to yourself, "I know. I don't need anything. I don't need any teacher and I don't need any guide. I can clean myself." You cannot. You cannot find even this building by yourself. If we didn't tell you where we were then you couldn't even find this address, this room. There are so many rooms and so many apartments (in this building). You cannot find it by yourself. And this is just the

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world. This is *Dunya*. The Paradise? If you know the Paradise then you start shivering again because you don't want to get lost in the paradise too. You want to go to your place where you have been designated. You cannot be running around wildly. Everything Allah SWT has created is in order."

21st century people, from young people to old people, they are saying "I don't need a guide and I don't need a teacher, I don't need a plan. Don't I have my five senses? Don't I have my intelligence? Don't I have a phone that has all the information in the world at my fingertips? Why should I go sit and associate with some man who is going to tell me that I am wrong?" Who is more intelligent than the proof of Islam, *Hujattul Islam* Imam Abu Hamid al-Ghazzali? Who can say? He was the greatest Professor in the greatest University in the whole world at his time, with knowledge of all

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the *dunya* knowledges and religious knowledges. But he himself realized that he could not trust his intelligence in this *Jihad al-Akbar*, in this waking up to control his ego. He said, "How could I trust evidence from my senses? Sight, to see with our eyes, is our most powerful sense- but we can stare at a shadow and conclude that it is fixed and doesn't move. But at the end of an hour of observation, we see that the shadow moved. Not all at once, but gradually, and that it was never actually fixed. The eye looks at a star and sees it as small as a coin, whereas it is in reality bigger than the earth. This showed me that trusting my senses leads to a judgment which reason itself shows as totally based on error." If you cannot even trust your eyes, then who or what can you trust?

Listen to this incident. Imam Fakhruddin Razi, who was one of the greatest scholars of Islam, was about to pass from this world. And sheytan

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came to his deathbed, this is the part that nobody is talking about, when you are about to pass, how the sheytan is going to come, how your ego is going to be crazy now, how your desires are going to be crazy, trying to trick you.

So sheytan came to him, and he was one of the greatest scholars of Islam. And sheytan said, 'how do you know that Allah exists?' He asked him. And Imam al-Razi, he started debating with sheytan on his deathbed. He gave a logical proof for Allah's existence, but then sheytan started to debate him and cut down his point. Again they went back and forth, back and forth, until sheytan had cut down one hundred arguments that Imam al-Razi had. Imam al-Razi, who was about to die, he was getting so tired and hopeless that he almost was going to lose his faith. This is real, this is not a story. This is real.

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But he had a Sheykh. And his Sheykh's voice came to his heart and said, "O my *Murid!* Tell that sheytan that you believe in Allah (SWT) without the need for any proof." When Imam al-Razi said that, sheytan ran away, because he knew there was no more room for doubt in the Imam's heart.

O Believers! Have we taken someone to help us, to guide us? That someone who has been trained by his Sheykh in a tradition of over one thousand years. That one who is keeping the *sunnats* alive. That one who is keeping and protecting the *Syariat*. That one who is not asking for anything. Because sheytan is making attacks on our faith minute by minute.

Have we taken anyone as our Helper, anyone who has fought sheytan, anyone who has conquered their ego, to teach us how to do the

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same? If we have not, then we have a long, difficult, lonely road to walk. If not, then when dajjal comes, we are going to be fooled very easily.

We were not sent to this world to turn it into a paradise for ourselves. Our home was Paradise. Our original home is in Paradise. But because of the disobedience, we were kicked out of our home. This *dunya*, it is the place of exile, it is a place of sadness and difficulty. This *dunya* it is a prison. This *dunya*, for the believers, it is a place of homesickness that even if this *dunya* is turned into everything that is giving you pleasure, you are going to be homesick. Because this is not your home. This is *dunya*, it is a place of test.

As Allah (SWT) is saying in Holy Quran:

BismillahirRahmanirRahim

“Be sure that we will test you with something of fear and hunger, some loss in goods or lives or crops- but give glad tidings to the patient.

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Those who say, when a disaster strikes them, “Indeed we belong to Allah, and to Him is our return.” Such are they on whom are blessings from their Lord, and Mercy. Such are the rightly guided.” (2/Bakara:155-157)

What's the value of Laylatu-I Qadr (The Night of Qadr)?

BismillahirRahmanirRahim

The Night of Qadr is the night that the Quran comes down from Lauhul Mahfudz. Then from there, given to the Prophet (PBUH), and according to the needs and the wants of his ummats at that time and also, of course, at this time, the Quran is for every time, and then it is sent according to the Ayats, to the different situations. It is referring to that. It is also known as month of the Quran, reading of the Quran.

So traditionally, as we learn from Sheykh Effendi, from the Evliyaullah, saying that Leylatul Qadr it is hidden in the month of Ramadan. It is heavily in the last ten days of Ramadan. It is heavy in the last ten days that is odd. Odd days. And heavily, it is on the 27th night. It may

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change. It may be earlier, it may be later. We are just saying it is heavy. It is hidden there so that everyone will now start looking for it. And the blessings that come to people who look for it, according to their intention in that, they may reach there, they may reach to the blessings of Leylatul Qadr.

So that is a very special time, that Qadr time, because the angels they are coming, Jibril (AS) will come with thousands of angels, they are going to come and they are going to circle around everywhere, looking to see the sincere servants of Allah and they will personally give selams to you. Giving selams to you. You are in zikr, you are in worship, the angels are finding you, to give selams to you. Those who are awake, they may feel it. There are certain signs, that the angels are giving selams to you, as there are certain signs, physically in the sky when it's Leylatul Qadr, that split second there everything in creations fall down to sujud, to sejdah.

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Everything in creations fall into sejdah to Allah SWT. If you catch that, then you are going to understand how this world it is Jahannam, and your heart will turn away, it'll be tasteless. You live in this world, you do things, but you are not going to be excited about this world anymore. You are going to be very excited about the next world because you are already witnessing the other world. And there are signs also in the morning time, how the sun is rising and it is Leylatul Qadr. Watch out.

The Osmanlis they are saying, don't wait for one night in Ramadan to find Leylatul Qadr. Treat every night like it is Leylatul Qadr. Treat every night, treat every night like it is holy. Because even the Alims, the Ulamas and the Evliyaullah, they are saying, 'which one is more holy now? Leylatul Qadr or the night of Jumma?' Because the jumma night, Thursday night, it is more holy than the two Eids combine. So many hadiths about the specialness of Jumma. Not too many

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about Leylatul Qadr. But Leylatul Qadr is when all that power of the Quran e-Kerim it is coming down. The night of power too. The power it is coming down. But the Jumma night that everyone is looking and say, 'ah! It's another night. So what?' The jumma night, that the Tarikats are keeping very high, they are welcoming the Jumma night now with zikr, they listen to sohbet, they are doing couple of things, praying, what we are saying, Maghrib and Isya' together, and praying Fajr time together. That is the Sultan of the days. That it is the day that so many events in history it happens on a Friday. That so many events in the ahir zaman is going to happen on a Friday. That Prophet (PBUH) is saying, if you pray isya' in Jamaat, you'll get the rewards as if you pray behind Hz Abu Bakr Siddiq (RA). And if you pray in Jamaat Fajr, you'll get the rewards as if you are praying in the Jamaat behind the Holy Prophet (PBUH).

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So, it is a special, very holy night. And the Osmanlis, the Turks, they are saying, treat every night like it is Leylatul Qadr. Because Allah is descending every night. In the last third of the night, every night, for this nation, not for earlier nations, for this nation, Allah is descending and Allah is saying, 'I'm here for you.'

Note: The specific time of **Leyletu'l-Qadr** is not dependent on the calendar, it is secret. The first verses of the Surah were sent down on the twenty-seventh of Ramadan, but the **Leyletu'l-Qadr** that follow do not have to be on the twenty-seventh of Ramadan. It may happen in the previous days or the following days. For example, **Leyletu'l-Qadr**, which was on the nineteenth of Ramadan last year, may be on the twenty-fifth this year. In accordance with His wisdom, Allah changes the location of this night during Ramadan. That's why our Sheikh recommends performing at least 2 special Rakats (1 Fatiha, 7 Kadir in each Rakat) prayer

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before going to bed in the last 10 nights of Ramadan.

- Second Rakat: 1 Fatiha, 3 Ikhlas

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EID UL FITIR – SALAT AL EID: ADAB AND SUNNAH

1. Washing (Ghusul) before going out for prayer:

“Abdullah bin Omar radiyallahu anh used to wash before going out for prayer on Eid al-Fitr.” Imam Nawawi rahimehullah, there is an agreement among scholars that it is recommended to wash for the Eid prayer. The reason why it is recommended to wash on Friday and similar occasions is also present on Eid, and it seems even more necessary during Eid.

2. Eating dates:

One of the sunnahs is to eat a few dates before going to the Eid al-Fitr prayer, because according to what was narrated from Enes bin Malik, "Rasulullah sallallahu wa sallam would not go out to the Eid al-Fitr (Ramadan) prayer

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without eating as many dates as the number of dates."

The reason why it is recommended to eat today is; It means to strictly refrain from fasting today and to make one feel that the fast is over.

3. Saying takbir on Eid days:

Saying takbir is one of the great sunnahs. As a matter of fact, Allah says: "This is so that you may complete the number and glorify and thank Allah for His guidance.

Velid bin Muslim said: I asked Evzai and Malik Bin Enes about reciting the takbir openly during Eid, and they answered: Yes, Abdullah bin Omar used to utter the takbir openly during the Eid al-Fitr (Ramadan) until the imam came out. Abu Abdurrahman al-Salami said: "They would say takbirs louder during the Eid al-Fitr than during the Eid al-Adha."

El dar qutni and others would recite the takbirs clearly until Ibn Omar reached the Musalla (the

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place where the Eid prayer would be performed), and then continue until the imam ascended the pulpit.

4. Celebrate:

Regardless of the words, people celebrating the holiday mutually is one of the etiquette of the holiday, for example: "May God accept it from us and from you", "May your holiday be blessed" and similar permissible celebrations. Jubeyr bin Nafir: When the companions of the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) met on Eid days, they would say to each other: "May Allah accept it from us and from you." Ibn Hajar said: The attribution of this hadith is good. The celebration was known among the Companions, and Imam Ahmet and other scholars gave permission for this. Undoubtedly, celebrations are among the good morals and good social phenomena among Muslims.

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The least that can be said on this subject is this: congratulate the one who congratulates you with a holiday. If the other person remains silent, you will also remain silent. Imam Ahmed rahimehullah said: If someone congratulates me, I will respond, otherwise I will not start the congratulation.

5. Dressing up and wearing beautiful dresses for holidays:

According to what was narrated from Abdullah bin Omar radiyallahu anhu, Omar radiyallahu anh bought a silk robe sold in the market and said to the Prophet sallallahu aleyhi wa sallam: O Messenger of Allah! Take this for the holiday and use it to welcome delegations from abroad. Thereupon, the Prophet (peace be upon him) said: "This is only the dress of those who have no share in the afterlife..." The Prophet (peace be upon him) admitted to dressing up for the holiday, but he did not accept it because the robe was made of silk.

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Jabir bin Abdullah radiyallahu anhu said: The Prophet (peace be upon him) had a robe that he wore on two Eid days and on Fridays:" [11] Beyhaki narrated with an authentic document that Ibn Omar wore his most beautiful dress on Eid days.

Undoubtedly, a Muslim goes to Eid with his best dress. Women, on the other hand, avoid ornaments when they go out because they are forbidden from showing their ornaments to men. Likewise, it is haram for a woman who wants to go out to wear perfume, because she went out only for worship.

6. Going to prayer one way and returning another way:

Jabir bin Abdullah radiyallahu anhume said: Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) would change the way on the day of Eid. It is said that this is for both paths of wisdom to witness it on the Day of Judgment. Because the

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earth will tell about the good and bad events that took place on it.

Some said: It is to show the slogan of Islam on both paths.

Some of them: To show the crowd with him, to anger the Hypocrites and Jews.

In another opinion; It has been said that it is to meet people's needs such as knowledge, fatwa, charity, and visiting relatives.

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FASTING IN THE MONTH OF SHAWAL:

Our Holy Prophet (pbuh) said, "Whoever fasts Ramadan and adds six days of Fasting in the month of Shawwal to it, it is as if he fasted the whole year." (Muslim, Siyam, 204 [1164]).

This fast can be kept for 6 consecutive days or with breaks (İbn Âbidîn, Reddû'l-muhtâr, 2/435).

FASTING IN THE MONTH OF SHEVVAL:

Hiz. The Prophet (pbuh) said, "Whoever fasts Ramadan and adds six days of Shawwal to it, it is as if he fasted the whole year." (Muslim, Siyam, 204 [1164]) he said. This fast can be kept for 6 consecutive days or with breaks (İbn Âbidîn, Reddû'l-muhtâr, 2/435).

Supererogatory fasting in the month of Shawwal does not replace fasting not kept in Ramadan; In other words, it is obligatory to make up for fasts not kept during Ramadan. Since it is not valid to

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intend for both qada and supererogatory fasts during a fast, it is necessary to intend only one of them in the fast of Shawwal. While fasting in the month of Shawwal, if one intends to make up for the fasts that could not be kept in Ramadan, these fasts will be kept as missed fasts.
